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bent larsen 1935 2010 was one of the greatest fighters chess has ever seen in his rich career the great dane defeated all world champions from botvinnik to karpov he was a candidate for the world championship four times and became one of the most successful tournament players of his time his uncompromising style and his unorthodox thinking made him popular with chess players all around the globe in 1967 1968 larsen won five international elite events in a row a truly spectacular achievement his successes were such that bobby fischer let him play first board in the legendary match soviet union vs the world in 1970 in belgrade bent larsen also was a highly original chess writer and an extremely productive chess journalist not surprisingly the first chess book that magnus carlsen ever studied was written by the strongest scandinavian player before him this collection brings together more than 120 of bent larsen s best games annotated by himself his comments are lucid to the point instructive and humorous together these games are a tribute to his genius and a continuous joy to read and play through

bent larsen is one of the outstanding figures of post war chess with top level tournament victories spanning five decades his outstanding fighting qualities have made him a great favourite with the chess public and even in the latter stages of his career he remained capable of sweeping victories over world class opposition while some other grandmasters have settled for an easy retirement larsen still fires on all cylinders

wilhelm steinitz the winner of the first official world chess championship in 1886 would have rubbed his eyes in disbelief if he could have seen how popular chess is today with millions of players all around the world live internet transmissions of major and minor competitions and educational programs in thousands of schools chess has truly become a global passion and what would steinitz who had financial problems his whole life and died in poverty have thought of the current world champion magnus carlsen who became a multi millionaire in his early twenties just by playing great chess the history of the world chess championship reflects these enormous changes and german chess journalist andre schulz tells the stories of the title fights in fascinating detail the historical and social backgrounds the prize money and the rules the seconds and other helpers and the psychological wars on and off the board meet some of the world s sharpest minds as they clash in what has been called the cruellest sport and drink in their tales the lonely geniuses the flamboyant boulevardiers the nazi sympathizers the communist darlings and a troubled boy from brooklyn relive the magic of capablanca alekhine botvinnik tal karpov kasparov bobby fischer and the others all great champions but so different in character and playing style schulz s chronicle is an absorbing evocation of the battles they fought he has also selected one defining game from each championship and he explains the moves of the champions and the ideas behind the moves in a way that is easily accessible for amateur players and highly instructive for beginners as well this is a book that no true chess lover wants to miss

most chess biographies present the games of famous players but not their writings filling that gap this book begins with syrian master and author of chess studies philip stamma and finishes with the first world champion william steinitz the main novelties in opening middlegame and endgame theory in the 160 year period are examined and biographical sketches put the contributions of more than 30 masters into context the author presents many new insights for example regarding the origins of the ponziani opening the dutch defense and the petroff defense french star la bourdonnais used other sources for almost every part of his nouveau traite morphy s analysis of the philidor defense was faulty and anderssen s play included many positional ideas harrwitz and neumann published modern treatises long before steinitz came out with his modern chess instructor many ending themes belong to less well known authors such as cozio chapais van zuylen van nyevelt sarratt kling and horwitz berger and salvio

the 20th anniversary edition in 1998 the authors set out to demonstrate the viability of the accelerated dragon as a weapon for black not fearing the maroczy bind or any other set up white can come up with in the intervening year the opening has been part of the opening repertoires of world top players such as carlsen ivanchuk and numerous other top grandmasters even though the original material is now older it is still very instructive and will enhance anyone s general understanding of chess and specifically of the accelerated dragon this book contains all the original

material of the first edition with some additional main games as well a couple of entirely new segments

four time us champion yasser seirawan provides a fascinating and highly entertaining account of his games and encounters with the world champions of chess including garry kasparov anatoly karpov bobby fischer boris spassky tigran petrosian mikhail tal vassily smyslov mikhail botvinnik and max euwe having been involved in frequent battles against world champions over a 25 year period seirawan is in an ideal position to reveal how it really feels to be facing the legends of the game he describes and analyses in depth his most memorable encounters both famous victories and painful defeats against the best chessplayers of the last 50 years during this time seirawan has also been highly active in off the board chess activities this has brought him into close personal contact with many of these champions in chess duels my games with the world champions seirawan recounts many stories involving these giants of the game giving an intriguing insight into their personalities away from the board

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
