sociology of death and the american indian examines dying death disposal and bereavement practices and applies those concepts to select american indian tribes historically and currently supplemented with oral histories the focus is that learning about other cultures can enhance the understanding of one's own culture by comparing traditional and modern societies gerry r cox addresses the centuries of injustices committed against american indians that led to a neglect of learning about american indian cultures and attempts to fill the gaps in knowledge of american indian practices

native and christian is an anthology of essays by indigenous writers in the united states and canada on the problem of native christian identity this anthology documents the emergence of a significant new collective voice on the north american religious landscape it brings together in one volume articles originally published in a variety of sources many of them obscure or out of print including religious magazines scholarly journals and native periodicals along with one previously unpublished manuscript

american history through hollywood film offers a new perspective on major issues in american history from the 1770s to the end of the twentieth century and explores how they have been represented in film melvyn stokes examines how and why representation has changed over time looking at the origins underlying assumptions production and reception of an important cross

section of historical films chapters deal with key events in american history including the american revolution the civil war and its legacy the great depression and the anti communism of the cold war era major themes such as ethnicity slavery native americans and jewish immigrants are covered and a final chapter looks at the way the 1960s and 70s have been dealt with by hollywood this book is essential reading for anyone studying american history and the relationship between history and film

mary white rowland won a new england congregationalist minister's wife was held captive by the algonquin indians during king philip's war in 1676 several years after she was ransomed and living among the british again she wrote a narrative of the captivity chronicling her experience in grief love resentment and ethnic trauma breitbart argues that this narrative undercuts the puritan values rowlandson attempted to uphold he reveals where and how rowlandson breaks with puritan conventions he points out that in american puritan religious practice real experiences were seen as signs or emblems of moral abstractions american puritanism and the defense of mourning will be essential reading for all who study early american literature and culture

now scattered in small communities in northern indiana the eastern miami indians once a well known tribe have lived in undeserved obscurity since the 1840s in recent years they have become more visible as they have sought restoration of treaty rights and have revitalized their culture the post removal history of the indiana miami tribe is a rich texture of social legal and economic history much enhanced by folklore and a rich series of photographic images in the miami indians of indiana a persistent people 1654 1994 rafert explores the history and culture of the miami indians

the world of the mid nineteenth century seneca indians comes vividly to life in this classic biography of missionaries asher and laura wright the wrights lived with the senecas for over forty years during which they translated parts of the new testament and hymns into the seneca language oversaw a periodical and recorded much about everyday reservation life and history their recollections are an indispensable source of information about traditional seneca life and the activities of missionaries among them it was a time of intense change for the senecas as they withdrew from the centuries old iroquois confederacy and increasingly embraced christianity the wrights recall religious disputes between christians and traditionalists on the reservation including a contentious christmas observance held within a longhouse a debate over the origins of the world and chief logan's fierce opposition to christian burial rites for a relative they helped to found and manage the first twenty years of the thomas asylum for orphan and destitute indian children later known as the thomas indian school which continued until the mid 1950s the wrights also provide valuable descriptions of seneca religious ceremonies eyewitness accounts of community events and conversions memorable speeches by red jacket and honondeuh and many seneca legends origin stories and historical accounts

with insight and precision the authors of these essays provide in depth examinations into eight american indian revitalization movements and the prophets who brought their religions to life they explore such topics as omens preceding the conquest of mexico militant religious revivals during the war of 1812 and prophets of accommodation such as kenekuk the washani and waptashi religions of the pacific northwest and one indian shaker church in california are detailed an important essay on wovoka the ghost dance prophet is also presented the editor has assembled a collection of excellent essays and has expertly tied them together in an interpretive introduction this is a fascinating book which should open new avenues of research and thinking about american indian prophets and revitalization movements back cover

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
